A Message from MMA's Junior High Lead, Ms. Emily



Catherine McTamaney, Ed.D. states, "Each child is filled with the unknowable, unpredictable greatness of potential." She reminds us that we can prepare, support, and reinforce the building the child is creating, but we cannot construct the house.

How important it is, then, that we model and help our children to develop a growth mindset? When our young ones understand, accept, and believe that their abilities, talents, and intelligence are not fixed, but rather can be developed through effort and persistence, we are enabling them to tap into that greatness of their potential.

Those with a growth mindset tend to replace the fear of failure with a drive toward challenge. Feedback becomes a welcomed friend who invites growth, rather than a punitive enemy. When desired results seem illusive, rather than giving up, they allow themselves time to improve and grow. Perseverance becomes the norm. No longer do they default toward the easy path, but charge toward a creative alternate route.

Let us structure our feedback and encouragement to embody the principles of a growth mindset. Praise the process and tie it to their effort. Remind them of strategies they have used in the past and acknowledge when they choose a challenge. If they seem discouraged guide them to steps they can take to improve the situation. Fill their toolboxes with strategies that support a growth mindset.
