Field experiences are an essential element of Montessori learning. The field experiences will support science standards and instruction.

Academic Areas

- Science

Measurements

Students will be given pre and post test essays that will assess their learning through the use of a four point rubric to determine mastery.

Action Plan Steps

1. Teachers meet as a Professional Learning Community (PLC) to plan field experiences that will support the teaching of science standards.
2. Trips will occur throughout the school year and teachers will present pre and post lessons to maximize student learning during the field experience.
3. Students will compose pre and post trip essays assessments based on a 4 point rubric to determine mastery of science standards.

Literacy skills will improve by 25% overall according to Acadience Testing (formally DIBLES) by completing the purchase of LETRS for the 2nd year of use.

Academic Areas

- Reading

Measurements

Students will be benchmarked in their literacy skills by using Acadience testing Beginning (BOY), Middle (MOY) and end (EOY) of year, as well as being progress monitored monthly in classrooms.

Action Plan Steps

1. Teacher PLC will review previous year's data.
2. Reading instruction and intervention programs will be reviewed.

3. Teachers will engage in their own grade level PLC to determine best practices to use programs.

4. Students will be assessed BOY, MOY, EOY as well as progress monitoring.

Professional development will be furnished to teachers at the school by either sending teachers to professional development and covering substitutes or by bringing applicable professional development to the school.

Academic Areas

- Reading
- Mathematics
- Writing

Measurements

After teachers attend specific professional development, they will implement principles learned as well as present to faculty regarding their experiences.

Action Plan Steps

1. PLC groups will identify applicable professional development.
2. Teachers will arrange for the opportunity to go.
3. Teachers will report back by implementing principles learned in classrooms as well as to faculty.
